The focus will then move to AGREX, the segment of the London Stock Exchange Group derivatives market dedicated to durum wheat. Helyette Geman, Professor of Finance at Birkbeck, University of London and member of the Board of the UBS-Bloomberg Commodity Index, and Nicolas Bertrand, Head of Equity and Derivatives Market at London Stock Exchange Group will also deliver speeches at the event.
